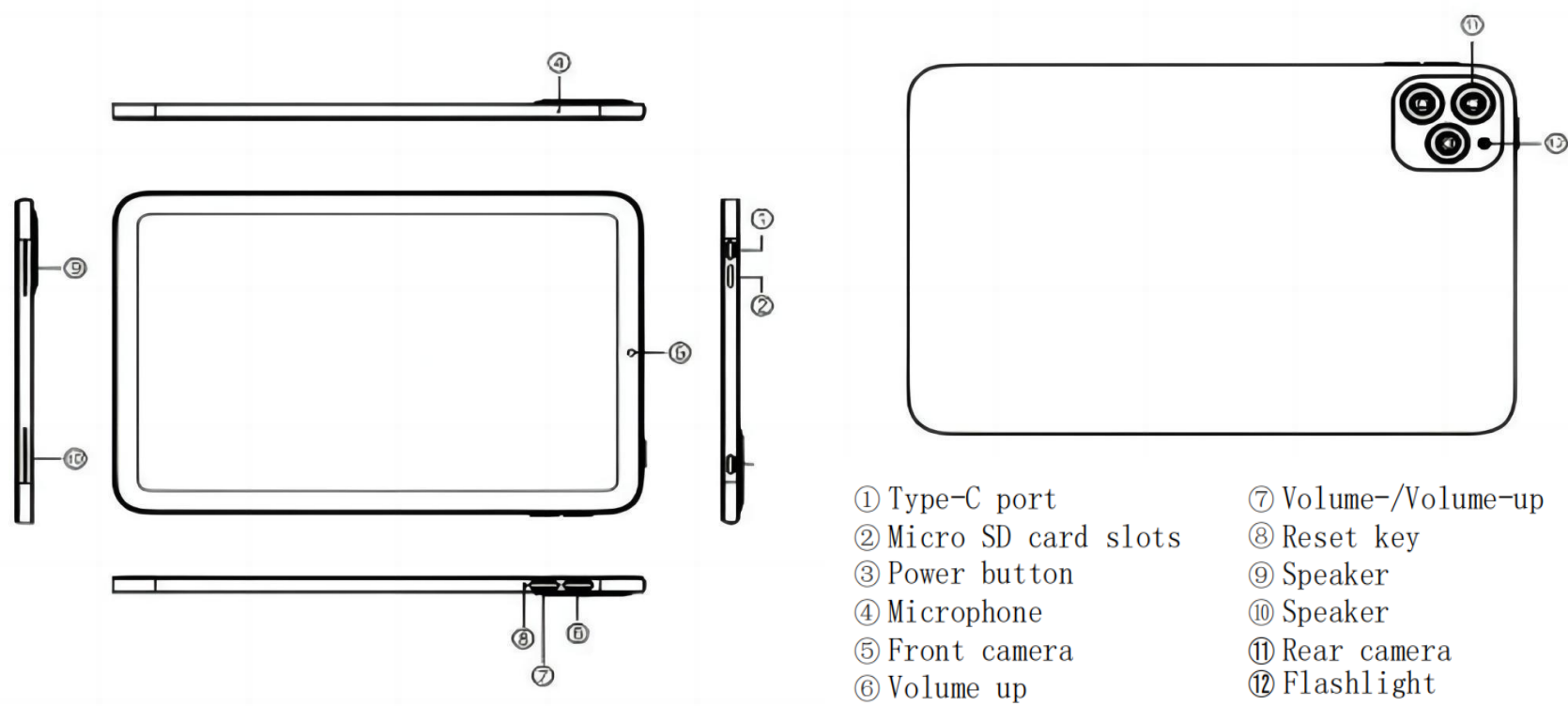


# Know the equipment

### Tablet power on/off instructions:

1. Turn on: Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds until the screen turns on and the startup animation appears.
2. Shutdown: When the tablet is turned on, press and hold the power button for 3 seconds, until the shutdown menu appears, and then select Shut down.
3. Forced shutdown: Press and hold the power button for more than 10 seconds to force shutdown.

### Operation and safety

To prevent possible hearing damage, do not use high volume for a long time.

Please use this device within the temperature range of 0°C-35°C and store the device and its accessories within the temperature range of -20°C to +45°C. Ambient temperatures that are too high or too low may cause the device to Fault.

Do not expose the device and its battery to high temperatures or near heating devices. , such as sunlight, heaters, microwaves, ovens, or water heaters. Overheating of the battery may cause it to explode.

When the device is charging, the power socket should be installed near the equipment, and should be easy to plug and unplug.

When charging is complete or not charging, please disconnect the charger from the device and unplug the charger from the electrical outlet.

Do not use the charger in wet locations, such as near a sink, bathtub, or shower., do not plug or unplug the charger with wet hands

This device uses a non-removable internal battery. Do not replace the battery yourself., so as not to cause device failure or battery damage.
